Further, in the meeting of DRC held on 07.03.2014, the department unanimously resolved to withdraw 04 seats and accordingly made admissions on 16 seats only. The bifurcation of seats was done as per detail given below:

In addition to above 16 seats, 02 candidates were admitted under JRF and 01 under International Sport Person Category under clause 15(b) and 15(c) of PhD Ordinance 2012-13. But as per merit list displayed for fee deposition on 19.03.2013, due to availability of only 01 candidate of BCB category, the left 01 seat of BCB category was converted by the department to BCA category and accordingly 03 candidates were admitted in BCA category instead of 02. Later on 02 candidates Ms. Reena (BCA category) and Mr. Amit Kumar (BCB category) were admitted in compliance of the order of Hon'ble High Court and District Court, Sirsa respectively.
