At the outset, the Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members in the 23rd meeting of the Academic Council. Thereafter, the agenda was taken up.

To start with it was pointed out that the word programme(s) is required to be mentioned in place of course(s) for all agendas related to scheme and syllabi under CBCS.

1. Confirmed the minutes of 22nd meeting of the Academic Council held on 15.02.2017 with the following amendments:

Item No. 61: Amended ordinance of M.Sc. (Mathematics) five year integrated programme except for lateral entry be implemented retrospectively i.e. from the very beginning of this programme.

Item No. 63: Amended ordinance of M.A. (Hons.) Economics five year integrated programme except for lateral entry be implemented retrospectively i.e. from the very beginning of this programme.

 - 2. These courses will be run under regular budgeted scheme and fee in respect of M.A. courses will be charged at par with fee charged in case of M.A. Public Administration and M.A. Economics. The nomenclature of the degree for M.Sc.-Geography as already approved by the E.C. on recommendations of the A.C., will be changed to M.A-Geography in interest of the students. It is necessary as the subject Geography is taught at college level in B.A. Course as one of the subjects.
 - 3. The eligibility criteria for admission in respect of subjects viz. Punjabi, Hindi, Sanskrit and History will be as prescribed by K.U. Kurukshetra. Further, the eligibility criteria in respect of admission in M.A.-Geography will be as under:
 - "B.A./B.Sc. degree with Geography as one of the subjects with 45% marks in aggregate (42.75% marks in case of SC/ST students)".

In case of University Teaching Department Rs. 12/- per student per annum shall be sent to the Account of Programme Officer, NSS, CDLU, Sirsa

and Rs. 8/- per student per annum shall be sent to the Account of Programme Coordinator, NSS, CDLU, Sirsa. The recommendation of the Fee Committee is at.

2. The recommendations of the committee regarding total fees concession to the persons with disabilities in regular courses. In case of SFS courses, where persons with disabilities are admitted, the number of seats equal to the number of admitted persons with disabilities should be increased as superanumary seats over and above the sanctioned intake and no fee/funds should be charged from disabled students.

Further, it was recommended that the request of Miss Neha D/o Sh. Krishan Lal, MCA student of this University may be considered sympathetically and fee submitted by her may be refunded she being a person with disability and no fee/fund may be charged from her for further study in MCA, as recommended by the Fee Committee.

(V) Noted the suggestion to take up all the cases of registration of Ph.D. in a single agenda for all the departments.
