AUCTION NOTICE

Offers in sealed cover for lifting of Raddi 146971 kg (Approx) lying in various Departments/offices/branches are invited from Dealers for lifting of Raddi. The offers complete in all respects, may be sent to **The Registrar, Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa** on or before **25.06.2021** upto **05.00** PM which shall be opened on **28.06.2021** at **12:00** Noon. Terms and conditions:

1. The quotation envelope should be addressed to the Registrar, CDLU, Sirsa and the envelope must be super subscribed **Quotation “Lifting of Raddi”**.
2. **The vendor should quote minimum rates Rs. 10.10 per kg and above.**
3. The University is auctioning Raddi having Answer Books, Notings, Letters and papers and therefore, the vendor will use the same as Raddi and shall not misuse the Answer Books, Notings & Letters etc of the University after lifting of Raddi.
4. The vendors shall have to deposit a security of Rs. 1,50,000/- in the shape of Fixed Deposit Receipt in favour of the Registrar, Chaudhary Devi Lal University. The security by other means except FDR shall not be accepted.
5. The material will be disposed – off on “as is where is” basis. The material can be inspected / seen on working days during hours (10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.) by contacting the Estate Office, General Branch, CDLU, Sirsa.
6. The highest bidder has to make full payment of total declared cost before lifting the material. The payment will be accepted in the shape of demand draft drawn in the favour of the Registrar, CDLU, Sirsa payable at Sirsa or payment can be deposited at university cash counter.
7. No complaint about the quantity, quality or condition of the material will be entertained after the auction. The material would be handed over to the highest bidder on “as is where is” basis. The university shall not be responsible for their usefulness or quality.
8. The rights to accept or reject the highest offer finally vests in the Registrar of the University.
9. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Vice – Chancellor of the university will be final and binding.

10. The highest bidder shall make his own arrangements for transportation, loading/Unloading and permit etc. if required, after acceptance of his bid. The bidder shall have to pay the local taxes, surcharge or any other tax with the concerned authorities, if applicable, in addition to the amount offered.
11. The security money deposited by the highest bidder will be adjusted in the total offered price.
12. The material will have to be lifted by the highest bidder within the 15 days after acceptance of the highest bid. Loading and lifting of the auctioned material shall be done by the purchaser only during the prescribed working hours of the University. No deliveries shall be affected during Sunday or Holidays.
13. In case the highest bidder is unable to lift the material in specified period after acceptance of his highest bid, the total amount deposited alongwith the security money deposit shall be forfeited by the University and the fresh bids will be called and accepted.
14. Highest bidder will be responsible for any damage done to the University by his labour directly or indirectly at the time of lifting the material.
15. If, sufficient bidders do not participate, in the auction, the Registrar of the University reserves the right to call for fresh bids. In such an event earnest money deposited by the bidder shall be refunded without interest.
