\* One student at Sr. No. 12 namely Ruchi D/o Surender Kumar was selected for POSE scholarship during the year 2016-17 and she has availed 1st and 2nd installment of scholarship. Now this student has taken fresh admission in M.Sc (Microbiology 1st year) in another university. Since the student has already availed the 1st and 2nd installment. She will not be given 1st and 2nd installment of scholarship and will be considered for 3rd and 4th installment based on her performance in 2nd and 3rd semester.

The amount of scholarships would be Rs. 6,000/- P.M. for entire 2-year M.Sc. course subject to fulfillment of the eligibility conditions of the scheme. Research Mentorship grant of Rs. 10,000/- (one time) for 2-year M.Sc. course would be released to the concerned students after submitting the project report as per the guidelines of the scheme. The amount of scholarships (semester-wise) will be released directly in to the bank accounts of the students through online bank transfer. Further, the students have to ensure the following:-

1. Submission of semester wise Detailed Mark Card (DMC):
  - a) Scholars are advised to submit their self attested semester Mark-sheets within One month after the announcement of semester results to facilitate the payment of scholarship.
  - b) If a scholar does not submit his/her semester mark-sheets the offer of scholarship shall be withdrawn.
  - c) Provisional or Internet copy of the Mark-sheets will not be considered.
  - d) The scholars are advised to submit the Actual Payee Receipts (APRs) of the amount received.
2. Candidates having Compartment / Re-appear in semester examination will not be considered for further installment of scholarship.
3. In case of re-appear or below 60% marks in any of the semester, the future installments of scholarships of the candidate will be withheld / discontinued. Candidates clearing the re-appear in supplementary examinations will not be considered for continuation of scholarships. In case of SGPA/SPI or any other index awarded by the university, the conversion would be done as per university approved formula. In case such university formula is not available the percentage will be derived by scaling down the SGPA by 10%. For example the SGPA is 6/10, the equivalent percentage would be taken as  $6/10 \times 0.9 = 54\%$ .


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4. Any change or re-admission to another College/ University/ Academic Institute within the same academic year is acceptable, provided the scholar pursues subjects out of identified 18 nos. subject(s). The Offer would stand invalid in case this change or re-admission occurs in the next academic year and thereon, or subject(s) pursued is/ are beyond the 18 identified subjects. In such a case, there will be no scope for restoration of the offer and no communication would be made separately to Scholar.
  5. Make all the correspondence for this purpose to the Secretary, EC, Haryana State Council for Science & Technology (HSCST), Bays 35-38, Sector-2, Panchkula and should route the same through their college / university concerned.
  6. The student selected under this scheme will not be entitled for any other scholarship.

In such a case, there will be no scope for restoration of the offer and no communication would be made separately to Scholar.

**GUIDELINES FOR POST GRADUATE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR  
UNIVERSITY RANK HOLDERS AT UNDER GRADUATE LEVEL**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

Higher Education has had played a very vital role in the history of nation building all over the world. It is amply clear that no rise in general standards of living and culture is possible without strengthening the higher education system in the country. It obviously calls for a multipronged strategy. There is a need to modernize our higher education system, and equally important to continuously attract young and talented students to pursue higher education. It is being increasingly observed that the brighter lot is not pursuing Post-Graduate education in our institutions of higher learning. To emerge as a powerful nation, there is an urgent need to bring in talented boys and girls in the field of Post-Graduate education by way of providing them good incentives in the form of scholarships. The UGC, therefore, introduced a Post-Graduate Merit Scholarship Scheme for University undergraduate rank holders.

The scholarship may be tenable for a period of two years to enable the rank holders of each university at undergraduate level to pursue their Master's Degree. All universities/degree awarding institutions would be required to issue rank certificates to the toppers of the university in B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com.

The purpose of this scheme is to attract talent for pursuing post graduate studies besides strengthening the basic subjects at Undergraduate level. The awardees, under this scheme, can pursue their Postgraduate programme in any area of specialization in any institution of higher learning in the country.

**2. OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME**

The objectives of the scheme are:

- 2.1. To promote and nurture talent;
- 2.2. To reward meritorious students with outstanding performance at the Under graduate level for pursuing postgraduate studies;
- 2.3. To promote study in basic courses at undergraduate level. Professional courses are not covered under the scheme;
- 2.4. To build up academic excellence at postgraduate level across the colleges and universities in the country.

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### 3.3. TARGET GROUP

- 3.1 The First and Second Rank Holders at undergraduate level and admitted in any Postgraduate Course would be awarded the scholarship. The students will have to submit the proof of their merit position at undergraduate level as well as their admission in postgraduate courses.
- 3.2 The scholarship would, however, be subjected to securing a minimum of sixty percent marks at undergraduate level.
- 3.3 The scheme is applicable to such students who have taken admission in regular, full-time Master's Degree course in any recognized university, deemed university, private university, autonomous college or a post graduate college.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The scholarship is available to the student for first PG Degree only. Age limit for the students is 30 years at the time of admission in PG course.
- 4.2 Distance mode of education will not be considered under the scheme.
- 4.3 The Undergraduate courses from following streams have been identified for the award of scholarships:  
1. Life Sciences 2. Physical Sciences 3. Chemical Sciences 4. Earth Sciences 5. Mathematical Sciences 6. Social Sciences 7. Commerce 8. Languages
- 4.4 Before forwarding applications students/Universities may ensure that application satisfy all norms as per guidelines.
- 4.5 The first and second rank holders (Not position holders) would be considered from Universities/ Institutions and non-affiliated/ autonomous colleges according to the number of students who have appeared in the examination at undergraduate level as per following table.

## 6. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

6.1 The candidates fulfilling the eligibility conditions are required to apply online through [www.ugc.ac.in/urh](http://www.ugc.ac.in/urh) against the advertisement to be published by the UGC once in a year through advertisement in leading newspaper and Employment News after obtaining admission in first year Post Graduate course in a recognized University/Institution/College.

6.2 The results of selection will be declared on UGC website.

6.3 Awardees would be required to download their award letter from the online portal by logging in with the registration id and Date of birth in the event of their selection.

## 7. AADHAAR SEEDING

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India vide its letter D.O. No. 18-7/2013-U1A dated 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 has instructed the University Grants Commission that from the financial year 2016-17 onwards the Aadhaar will be used as an identifier for disbursement of all Government subsidies/Scholarships/Fellowships which are to be disbursed directly into the beneficiary's account. Accordingly, Aadhaar will be used as an Identifier for release of grant under the scheme.

## 8. NATURE OF ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE UNDER THE SCHEME

Amount of fellowship: Rs.3.100/- p.m for a period of two years only (10 months in the year) i.e. full duration of a PG course. No other additional grant will be payable in lieu of hostel charges and medical charges etc.

## 9. PROCEDURE FOR RELEASE OF GRANTS BY UGC

9.1 The fellowship amount shall be disbursed through UGC designated agency into the bank account of the awardee directly with effect from the date of joining of the candidate in the first year of Post graduate course as certified by the host institution in the joining report. The list of designated branches of UGC identified agency is available on the UGC portal i.e. [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in).

9.2 The awardee is required to approach the designated branch along with a Copy of the Award Letter and Joining Report with photograph, address and contact number in the prescribed proforma Annexure-I.

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9.3 The awardee is also required to submit the following documents to the designated branch of the UGC designated Bank at the stipulated period interval.

9.3.1 At the end of every three months the awardee shall submit a 'Continuation Certificate' in the prescribed proforma. **Annexure-II**. This will make the awardee eligible to draw the fellowship for the next three months.

9.3.2 After completion of one year of the award of fellowship, the concerned awardee shall submit and present his/her Progress Report in the proforma prescribed by the UGC as given in **Annexure-III**.

**NOTE:** The approved Agency may verify the genuineness of records before disbursement of funds.

## 10.- PROCEDURE FOR MONITORING

10.1 The progress of the candidate shall be monitored by the head of the department. The candidate is required to submit a yearly progress report duly signed by the Head of the Department and Registrar of the University or Head of the Institution or Principal of the College to the designated bank branch. The scholarship shall stop after the last academic year of the Post graduate programme.

10.2 Any student who discontinues the studies without prior approval of the UGC will have to refund the whole amount through e-mode (RTGS/NEFT) directly to UGC account.

10.3 No extension is permissible beyond two years.

10.4 The student who is awarded Post-Graduate Scholarship for University Rank Holders will not be debarred from accepting any other scholarships.

10.5 The student availing this scheme will submit a certificate/mark sheet of completion of Post Graduate course duly signed by the Head of the department.

## 11. CANCELLATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

The UGC may terminate the scholarship of any student in any of the following cases:

11.1 Misconduct of the awardee, if any, reported by the University/ Institution.

11.2 Unsatisfactory progress report (i.e. if the candidate scores less than 60% marks in the first year of Master's programme).

11.3 Candidates being found ineligible at a later date shall face the penal action and will also be liable to refund the entire Scholarship amount paid.

- The Scholar will be on probation during first six months after joining URS. Confirmation of the award will depend upon the satisfactory completion of the period of probation.
- The scholar will be required to do whole time research work.
- The scholars have to mark their attendance in the department concerned throughout the duration of their scholarship.
- The University Research Scholar may be allotted a teaching work load upto 06 hrs / week without any additional remuneration.
- The scholar will have to submit a report of progress of research work every six months to the Chairperson (endorsed and forwarded by the supervisor) of the department concerned. Reports of progress, satisfactory or otherwise shall be considered by the DRC, which will make its recommendations to higher bodies. The continuance of the scholarship would depend on the satisfactory progress of work of the scholar(s).
- All the scholars will be governed by the Ordinance-'Doctor of Philosophy' & 'URS' rules of this University as applicable at the time of their admission.
- The URS shall complete the full period of his/her tenure of the scholarship. In the event, the scholar discontinues or give up his scholarship and leave the Department without prior permission of the Vice-Chancellor, during the period of scholarship or extended period, if extension was allowed, for no valid reasons, or the scholar concerned fails to submit his/her PhD Thesis within the time period prescribed in the PhD Ordinance, he/she shall refund the whole amount of scholarship paid by the University or a part thereof as recommended by the Chairperson in consultation with the Supervisor concerned.
