At the outset the Vice-Chancellor welcomed the Members to  $10^{th}$  meeting of the Academic Council. Thereafter the agenda was taken up.

1. Considered the minutes of 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.04.2010 and circulated vide No. Acad./102/10/385-416 dated 08.04.2010.

The Chairperson, Department of Law pointed out that item No. 14 of the meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.04.2010 was deferred only and not deferred for reconsideration by the PGBOS&R and the Faculty.

It was **RESOLVED** that this may be looked into and rectified, if required on the basis of the record available in the Department.

Thereafter the minutes were confirmed with the following additions/modifications:

- (i) Exemption from the Entrance Test for Ph. D. should be strictly as per UGC guidelines and that there should be no contradiction of UGC guidelines in the new Ph. D. Ordinance. This may be looked into by the Deans Committee under the Chairmanship of Dean Academic Affairs.
- (ii) To begin with, there will be 4-5 scholarships depending upon the availability of funds/resources. For this purpose a committee may be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor. The matter may also be reported to the Finance Committee in its next meeting.
- 2. Noted the action taken report on the decisions of the previous meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.04.2010 (Annexure-II Pages 30-31, already circulated).
- 3. Considered the recommendations of the HBI Draft Committee made in its meeting held on 22.04.2010 and 11.05.2010 and the draft of the HBI for the session 2010-11 prepared by the Committee.

**RESOLVED** to approve the Draft HBI prepared by the Committee with the following stipulations:

- (i) It may be mentioned in the HBI that admission to the following courses will be made subject to the permission of BCI/NCTE:
  - (a) LL.B. 3 year (professional)
  - (b) B. A. LL. B. 5 year integrated course
  - (c) Bachelor of Physical Education (B. P. Ed.)
  - (d) Certificate course in Physical Education (C. P. Ed.)
- (ii) The Committee also will look into the mistakes/printing errors, if any, in the draft HBI as given in writing by the members of the Academic Council.

### 4. Any other item.

Considered the following recommendations of the Committee of Chairpersons made in its meeting held on 14.05.2010, regarding the internal assessment in various papers/subjects:

- 1. The Internal Assessment of students will be purely based on performance of students in **two sessional tests**. In case of odd semesters, the tests will be held in the months of September & November, whereas, in case of even semester, the tests will be held in the months of February & April.
- 2. The Sessional Tests will be organized by respective departments in a centralized manner for which the Answer sheets will be provided by the University.
- 3. In case a student fails to appear in any sessional test due to any official engagement, he/she may be given one more opportunity by the respective Chairperson on his/her request duly supported by documentary evidence.
- 4. The passing percentage in theory papers will be minimum passing marks required by combining the marks of theory and internal assessment and it will not be mandatory to pass in the internal assessment.
- 5. The record of internal assessment including award lists along with answer sheets will be maintained upto 3 months from the date of declaration of result by the concerned teacher(s).
- 6. The above decisions will be implemented in all semesters from the next academic session i.e. 2010-11.

7. In the case of Department of Law, the scheme already in force as per ordinance shall be applicable as per Bar Council of India rules.

The Chairman, Department of Law informed that since the above procedure is not against the guidelines prescribed by the BCI, the above procedure/guidelines may also be made applicable in respect of the courses in the Department of Law.

**RESOLVED** to approve the above recommendations at serial No. 1 to 6. **FURTHER RESOLVED** to constitute the following Committee to suggest the procedure/guidelines for the test, including paper setting, evaluation, reevaluation, etc.:

- (a) Prof. Sultan Singh
  Dean Academic Affairs
- (b) Prof. B. P. Singh Chairperson, Department of Law
- (c) Prof. Praveen Aghamkar Controller of Examinations

In the end of the meeting the Academic Council **RESOLVED** to place on record the appreciation for the services rendered by Sh. R. K. Sehgal, who is retiring as Registrar of this University today.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
