He has also appreciated the efforts made by the Faculty Members of the University in launching NEP-2020 successfully and revising the curriculums as per Learning Outcomes based Curriculum Framework of all Post Graduate Programmes running in University Teaching Departments and Graduate Programmes in USGS.
