- (iii) Approved/Regular Teachers selected as per prescribed procedure/UGC guidelines, working in Universities or affiliated colleges/institutions having at least 3 year regular teaching experience.
- (vi) Foreign students holding valid research visa for doing Ph.D. They will be required to pay the fee in foreign exchange.

- (c) **Sub Clause (iv) of Clause 14 may be deleted.**

- (d) **The word ‘Joint Supervisor’ wherever used in the Ordinance be replaced with ‘co-supervisor’.**

- (e) **The entitlement to supervise the number of scholars in Clause 17 may be revised as under:-**

- (f) **In Clause 18, sub clause (iii) may be amended as under:-**

- (iii) Three Teachers (at least one Lecturer) having Ph.D. Degree on the basis of seniority by a rotation for two years, and

- (g) **The following may be added in the first para of Clause 25:-**

However, the Vice-Chancellor may, if he is satisfied that the candidate has already done sufficient work on the same topic elsewhere, allow him to submit the thesis on completion of one and a half year from the date of registration, on the recommendations of DRC/PG Board of Studies.

- (h) **In Clause 22 the words “except the courses being offered through Distance Education mode” be deleted.**

- (i) **Following may be added in Clause 17 as Note-02:-**
The seat may be treated as vacant on submission of thesis by a candidate.
 - (j) **Clause 28 may be amended as under:-**
The PGBOS & R may allow the title/synopsis of the research problem to be modified upto 2 years after the date of registration.....
 - (k) **Clause 29 may be modified as under:-**
Change of supervisor will not be allowed at the whims of the candidate. However, if the supervisor of the candidate resigns from the University or proceeds on long leave (at least for two years) or in case of his death before the completion of the research work or is otherwise unable to supervise the work due to some valid reasons, Vice-Chancellor may allow the change of the supervisor as requested by the candidate on the recommendations of the DRC, if he is satisfied that a candidate has not progressed adequately with the work and change of the supervisor is in the interest of the completion of the work. The supervisor who has left/proceeded on leave may continue as co-supervisor of the candidate.
 - (l) **The word ‘refereed’ may be deleted in Clause 31.**
 - (m) **The following sentence may be added in para 02 of Clause 31:-**
The candidate shall also submit a soft copy of the thesis in CD, in M.S. word/PDF format.
 - (n) **Clause 33 may be modified as under:-**
The DRC, on the recommendations of supervisor, will draw a list of sufficient number..... for each thesis.
 - (o) **In Clause 35 and 37 the words ‘3 evaluators/examiners’, may be replaced with ‘2 evaluators/examiners’.**
 - (p) **In Clause 37, the words ‘If two or more’ may also be replaced with the words ‘If one or both the’.**
 - (q) **The following may be added in Clause 37:**
“if one of the examiners rejects the thesis, the same will be sent to the third examiner/evaluator”.
