Notification

The Vice-Chancellor is pleased to approve the proceedings of the meeting of all Deans, Dean Research, Chairpersons, Professor Pankaj Sharma and Dean Academic Affairs held on 12.10.2020 at 2.30 PM in the Committee Room, CV Raman Bhawan, CDLU, Sirsa regarding amendments in Ph.D. ordinance, URS rules and provisions with regard to Ph.D. admission/classes for the session 2020-21 under 11(6) of the University Act in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council:

1. The commencement of classes for Ph.D. course work for the session 2020-21 will be from 18.11.2020.
2. Research Publications and Ethics course is assigned as **RPE-04** code. The course of Research Publications and Ethics will be taught common for all the Departments of the University. The course contents have been prepared by all the Deans and Dean Research and attached at **Annexure-I**. The Dean Research will identify the teacher(s) for teaching this course, classroom and notify the common time table. In case the students are more than 50, a separate section will be arranged by the Dean Research. The Chairperson will ensure the inclusion in the scheme of examinations, approval of the course content by the staff council, PGBOS&R and the faculty level. The Controller of Examinations may tick the paper setter from the panel of any department.
3. The courses will be taught as per approved ordinance under Clause 8.3 and Research Methodology paper for Ph.D. course work will be taught department wise.
4. Research and Publication Ethics paper shall be compulsory to pass (to avoid any complication at later stage) as deficient paper for candidates who are exempted from the course work within two years from the date of admission.
5. If any seat is vacant in any category in the department, the seat will be filled up from the waiting list of the said category, then convert DSC to SC and vice-versa, BCA to BCB and vice-versa etc., even if there is no candidate in these categories, the seats except SC/DSC will be filled from the waiting list of General Category on 17th November, 2020 by the Department and fee will be deposited on 17th & 18th November, 2020 accordingly.
