The committee considered the existing system of appointment of examiners for practical examinations, as per decision of the Academic Council taken vide Resolution No. 13 in its meeting held on 17.03.2018, which is as under:

Noted the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor on 17.01.2018 u/s 11(6) of the University Act in approving to appoint practical examiners by the Chairpersons of the University Teaching Departments from the latest panel of examiners of concerned PG Programmes or in case the practical examiners are not available from the existing latest panel they can appoint practical examiners from the affiliated Colleges where concerned PG courses/ Programmes are being run.

Further, resolved to approve as above at the level of Chairperson PGBOS&R and UGBOS as the case may be, instead of the Chairperson of University Teaching Departments as stated above.

Accordingly, the panels of examiners for practical exams in various affiliated colleges are decided by the Chairperson of UGBOS and PGBOS at present.

Pros and Cons:

If the decision of panel of practical examiners is left with the discretion of Principals as requested, it can dilute the decision of the Academic Council. Therefore, the committee is of the opinion that Chairperson of UGBOS and PGBOS suggest three names out of the approved panel. In case, if any practical examiner out of the suggested panel did not turn up, the Principal of concerned college will contact the Chairperson of UGBOS/PGBOS well in time for appointment of alternate examiners. The concerned Principal or Head of the concerned Department should also contact the examiner for the conduct of practical examiner well in advance. To maintain the credibility of the examination system, same practical examiner should not be repeated in the concerned practical examination in next semester/year as far as possible.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
