#### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

## (Action Taken Report)

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a noble experiment in academic expansion. It inculcates the spirit of voluntary work among the students and teachers through sustained community interactions. It brings out academic institutions closer to society. It shows how to combine knowledge and action to achieve results, which are desirable for community development. NSS at Ch. Devi Lal University was established with the objective of providing student youth with an opportunity to develop their overall personality by taking part in various Social Service Schemes. An Eleven member NSS Committee under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor is there for smooth functioning of NSS. Various units of NSS organized regular and special camping activities during the period.

- One day camps were organized in the University Campus to perform the regular activities
  related to community work like campus cleanliness, eradication of wild grass, anti
  polythene driveand, National voter day etc. One special camp of seven-days was
  organized from March 11-17, 2016. During the camp volunteers performed different
  project activity like tree plantation, general cleanliness and personal hygiene, blood
  donation, AIDS, women welfare programme, female feticide, literacy activity etc.
- Observance of Sabhavana Diwas was celebrated on 20-08-2015 and Sadhavana fortnight was celebrated on September 05, 2015 in the University Campus.
- International literacy day was organized on September 08, 2015.
- NSS day was celebrated by the volunteers on September 24, 2015.
- National integration day was celebrated in the university on 31/10/2015 on the occasion of Sardar Patel Jyanti.
- A debate on the topic women empowerment was organized on 19/10/2015; various students participated in the discussion and presented their view.
- A programme on Swacch Bharat Swasath Bharat and health awareness (motivated by Dr. R.S.Sharma, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor) was organized in the university campus in the first week of November, 2015.
- The NSS volunteers performed the discipline duty during the Youth festival of the University from November 05-07, 2015.
- Total 607 NSS merit certificates were given for the year 2014-15 to NSS volunteers of various affiliated colleges and University Teaching Department on the basis of recommendations from the concerned institutions.
- In addition to this earlier University have adopted the five villages (Chattergarh Patti, Nezedala, Vaidwala, Sikenderpur, handikhera) as per direction of Director General of Higher Education Haryana, Panchkula for the participation of Youth in the Swachh Bharat Mission. Different awareness rallies and door to door contact programmes were organized to aware the people about Swachh Bharat Mission and Beti-Bachao-BetiPadaooprogramme.

- One day camps were organized in the University Campus to perform the regular activities related to community work like campus cleanliness, eradication of wild grass, anti polythene drive etc. One special camp of seven-days was organized from March 22-28, 2017. - On 18/10/2016 University Workshop on Digital India was organized and in total 270 persons from various affiliated colleges/institutions/UTD participated in the workshop. Prizes were given in various activities to different teams of colleges/UTD.
- Rashtriya Ekta Diwas was celebrated on 31/10/2016.
- University Workshop on Cashless Society was organized on 13/01/2017. In this workshop Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor was the chief guest and Registrar, Dean Academic Affairs, DSW along with teaching staff/Programme Officers and Student/NSS Volunteers participated. In this programme some of the selected NSS volunteers/Students from affiliated colleges/UTDs along with Programme officers were trained in various modes of Digital Payments. In this programme in total nearly 270 persons participated and were given training about the various aspects of Cashless Society.
- Total 741 NSS merit certificates were given for the year 2015-16 to NSS volunteers of various affiliated colleges and University Teaching Department on the basis of recommendations from the concerned institutions.
- In addition to this earlier University have adopted the five villages (Chattergarh Patti, Nezedala, Vaidwala, Sikenderpur, Handikhera) as per direction of Director General of Higher Education Haryana, Panchkula for the participation of Youth in the Swachh Bharat Mission.

- NSS Unit CDLU organized special seven day camp from 17/03/2018 to 23/03/2018 in adopted village Chattergarh Patti. Total 100 Volunteers (50 Boys and 50 Girls) participated in the camps. During the camp volunteers perform different project activities like tree plantation, general cleanliness, personal hygiene Awareness about AIDS, women welfare programmes, female feticide, literacy activity, blood donation, first aid and home nursing, awareness rally and door to door contact programmes etc.
- NSS Unit CDLU organized special one day camp on 18-02-2018, 04-03-2018 and 25-03-2018. During the camp volunteers performed different activities like eradication of wild grass, campus cleanliness, rally organized for water conservation & drug addiction and anti polythene drive etc.

- Total 986 NSS merit certificates were given for the year 2016-17 to NSS volunteers of various affiliated colleges and University Teaching Department on the basis of recommendations from the concerned institutions.

- NSS Unit CDLU organized special seven day camp in March.   (SBSI)-2018. Students performed different activities related to awareness in the selected
